So here are my suggestion to keep you stronger and hopefully it will help you protecting against these viruses: Get enough sleep, eat healthy diet, be active, get enough sun light, be social (talk on the phone, meet up virtually or outside)and keep up the hand sanitization, 6ft social distancing and wear masks. Please continue to stay well and healthy!!

Community Center Reopening—COVID-19

Board of Selectmen approved to open at the Community Center for Senior program inside but with certain limitations and procedures. Just like all other our town buildings we request that you wear a mask unless you have a medical condition plus maintain social distancing.

Phases 3 Participants' Entrance Procedures for Atkinson Recreation Senior program at the community center:

- Preregister for the program is encouraged.
- Follow the Sign on door indicating 6ft social distancing precautions, followed by the following bullets: Signs on the door to inform visitors; take temperature, ask other COVID-19 questions. No one with a temperature of 99.9 or above will be admitted in the building. COVID-19 screening questions regarding your health and travel will be requested on a written form. A permeant record will be kept for contact tracing.
- While participants get screened one at a time, all other participants must wait outside the entrance on the ramps keeping a six foot Social Distancing between individuals. Please adhere to the orange social distancing markers on the ramps.
- Entrance to Atkinson Community Center will require a mask over nose and mouth when around others. Disposable masks are available in office.
- Stop at sanitizing station and sanitize hands. Sanitizing station will be set up on the hallway and a few other locations.

During the programs

- Exercise Classes will be held outside whenever possible.
- 6 Feet of social distancing and wearing a mask required inside the building.
- Exercise and Dance Classes held indoor in the Banquet Room, encourage wearing masks and spaced 8 feet apart and less than 30 people.
- Limit non-exercise classes size up to 60 people or less for Banquet room, 6 people for Room 1 and 12 people for Room 2.
- Allow a half hour between classes to give staff members time to clean
- Participants must bring their own water bottle
- Zoom classes might be available for some classes
- No food or beverages will be supplied by Atkinson Recreation

Exit Procedure

- Attendees will be directed into the program, then asked to leave promptly following the program and activity.
- Gatherings in the building, following a program or activity, is prohibited.

Pickleball courts at Woodlock Park

4 Pickleball courts are lined with different color within our 2 tennis courts at Woodlock Park. There are 2 Pickleball nets, so residents can use 2 courts on one of tennis courts. Tennis players still have access to one court. When you play either sports, please be respectful to other players. If players are waiting, limit of playing time for singles-45 minutes and doubles-I hour. Due to COVID-19—Do not enter the courts if you have any symptoms or feel sick, keep 6ft social distancing as much as possible, if not, wear face masks. Wash or sanitize your hands often. Only players on courts. Place personal items at least 6 feet from other player's items to avoid any contact.
