9. Non-Public Session Under NH RSA 91-A:3, II (d), for consideration of the acquisition of land

The Commission went into non-public session at around 8:25 PM.

Chair Wainwright gave an update on the status of the discussions between Deborah Lang and Sally Manikian of the Conservation Fund, and stated that they are close to signing a Purchase and Sale agreement for The Conservation Fund to purchase the land on Atkinson's behalf.

Chair Wainwright also reported that the Aquatic Resource Mitigation (ARM) fund is requiring that a separate, deeded conservation easement be placed on the land, and held by a qualified organization, and he is negotiating with the Southeast Land Trust to do that.

Chair Wainwright handed out the two attached budget estimates for the "best case" and "worst Case" funding that would be needed from the Town to complete the acquisition of the land by the Town. In order for The Conservation Fund to acquire the land on our behalf, they need to be assured that the Town of Atkinson will follow through with purchasing the land from them even in the unlikely event that neither the LCHIP or ARM funding comes through.

Chair Wainwright asked for a motion in this regard.

Member Nenart made a motion to re-affirm our commitment to acquire the 15-acre Lang parcel at the end of Knightland Road regardless of the

availability of grant funding, and, pursuant to RSA 36-A:5 II, to conditionally approve expending for this purpose from the town's conservation fund up to the worst-case cost estimate of \$301,700, conditioned upon holding a Public Hearing pursuant to RSA 36-A:5 II, and conditioned upon a vote by the Select Board to accept the land as Town property pursuant to RSA 36-A:4 I. Alternate Fried seconded the motion. Vote: 7/0/0, the motion carried.

Vice Chair Steele made a motion to exit non-public session. Member Kukshtel seconded. Vote: 7/0/0, the motion carried.

The meeting continued in public session around 8:40 PM.
