14. Non-Public Session Under RSA 91-A:3, II (d) for the consideration of the acquisition of land

Alternate Fried made a motion to go into a non-public session under RSA 91-A:3, II (d) for the consideration of the acquisition of land. Vice Chair Steele seconded the motion. Vote: 7/0/0

The Commission entered non-public session.

a. Boulder Cove Road land (Map 20 Lot 37-1)

Chair Wainwright reported that he has been in contact with landowner Susan Beckhorn, who has informed him that she would like to donate her land to the town. Chair Wainwright continued that there are still issues to be worked out concerning the title to this land, and he has scheduled a meeting with Town Attorney Sumner Kalman on Thursday 9/23 to find out what needs to be done to produce clear, marketable title to the land, which is one of the criteria for the town to acquire it. Attending with him will be Denise Legault and Selectman Bob Worden.

Chair Wainwright went on to say that he is optimistic about the prospects of acquiring this land, and has arranged for surveyor Tim Lavelle to mark the

boundaries and note any encroachments, for a cost estimate of \$500. Chair Wainwright asked for a motion.

Vice Chair Steele made a motion to hire James Lavelle and Associates to mark the boundaries of Map 20 Lot 37-1, document the status of the minor encroachments that are noted on Plan D-38102, note any additional encroachments, and to also to check and replace, if necessary, the boundary marker at the southeast corner of the abutting Map 23 Lot 87, which was the subject of an encroachment complaint onto the Marshall Town Forest last year, this work to be paid for from the Other Professional Services line in our 2021 annual operating budget. Member Fournier second the motion. The motion carried 7/0/0.

b. Knightland Road land (Map 18 Lot 40)

Chair Wainwright also reported that, as with the Boulder Cove Road property, Attorney Kalman has advised the Commission that there are title problems with this land as well, and has advised us not to negotiate terms and conditions of a sale until these are resolved. Ms. Lang has agreed to allow us to perform a Natural Resources Inventory in preparation for anticipated grant applications, and has sought proposals from two qualified individuals. The first was from wetland scientist Marc Jacobs for \$2250.00, and the second was from Rick Van de Poll, for \$1850.00. Rick is very well known and respected in New Hampshire for this type of work, and Chair Wainwright requested a motion to hire him to do the work. A copy of his proposal is attached.

Member McVay made a motion to hire Rick Van de Poll to perform a Natural Resources Assessment of Map 18 Lot 40, as described in the attached proposal, this work to be paid for from the Other Professional Services line in our 2021 annual operating budget. Member Kukshtel seconded the motion. The motion carried, 7/0/0

There being no other business to conduct in non-public session, Chair Wainwright requested a motion to close non-public session.

Member Steele made a motion to close the non-public session. Member Fournier seconded the motion. The motion carried 7/0/0.

The meeting resumed in public session.
