

## A4-Agricultural Use -


Land containing at least (5) acres which is used for raising livestock or agricultural or forest products; including farm structures and the storage of agricultural equipment; riding and boarding stables; and, as an accessory use, sale of agricultural products. Agricultural use shall not include permanent sawmill operations, and non-residential uses shall meet the non-residential requirements of this ordinance and be consistent with requirements under RSA 21:34-a Definition of Farm, Agriculture and Farming.




