## **RULES FOR CAMPAIGNING OUTSIDE ATKINSON COMMUNITY CENTER**

1. No campaigning of any kind to be conducted anywhere on Atkinson Community Center property except in the designated roped-off area, "the corral".



- 2. No signs allowed in the Right of Way in front of Atkinson Community Center. No signs may be posted on the Community Center side of the street.
- 3. In the interest of safety, no one is allowed to stand in the Right of Way in front of Atkinson Community Center (with the exception of official police details).
- 4. All campaign signs must be held by a living human being. No signs may be left upright without being held by a human. All signs not held by a human must be placed face-down on the ground.
- 5. Displaying any form of campaign material (including buttons, shirts, hats, body paint, etc.) on one's person is not allowed in the Atkinson Community Center building.

- 6. Only those voting or waiting to vote are allowed in the portion of the Atkinson Community Center building being used for voting. The only exceptions are election officials, moderator's assistants, and voting observers approved by the moderator.
- 7. Candidates are not allowed in the Atkinson Community Center building except to vote (or to use the bathroom).
- 8. Vehicles with campaign signs affixed may not be parked in the Atkinson Community Center parking lot.
- 9. Campaign workers who will be holding signs for a long period during the day, please park off-site to leave live parking spaces for voters.
