

Simple Steps for a Healthy Lawn

- 1. Choose the right grass seed for NH climates such as low maintenance fescue mixes.
- 2. Don't overwater, no more than 1" of water per week.
- 3. Test your soil every Spring pH matters!
- 4. Mow smart, no shorter than 3" high.

Do your part for healthy lawns and to protect water quality!

When Your Lawn Needs Fertilizer

- 1. Determine how much to apply safely. Measure and apply only what's needed. Store unused fertilizer for use next year.
- 2. Apply after expected rainfall.
- 3. Know when and where to apply.

 Apply at spring green-up and no later than mid-September.
- 4. Choose the Right Fertilizer. Use low or no phosphorous and formulas of 20N-0P-15K.
