## Liaison Reports:

- Wendy said the library is doing a good job getting funds from donations (\$2200 from friends, \$500 from trustees), using coupons. Kay mentioned \$300 from NH Humanities Council, and \$8000 from late fees.

- Sue, Peter, Kay, and Tom discussed alternate vehicle fuel providers, e.g. Depot in Kingston, Cumberland Farms, AL Prime, Sunoco, and other possible places, which would probably be cheaper than the current Mobil place (in another state).

- Tom requested info on how to get 501(c)3 status, as Elderly services would need that to get cars other than from the Police Department, and the wheelchair van will need to be replaced in about 2-3 years. Kay said Friends of the Library has done it, and the Womens' Civic Club is also doing it.

- Sue said Chief Brackett said paper goods are cheaper to buy himself than delivered from Staples or Mason.

- Wendy said Rose did a good job buying used file cabinets for Town Hall.
