The workshop was called to order at 7:40 pm by Sue Killam.

New Business:

Carol Grant came to the Planning Board and gave an overview of the status for the Scenic and Cultural Byway Project.

Carol told the Board that the State had lost the application for about 3 years and that it was found after Carol made numerous phone calls to the DOT. The application had been lent out to another Town, was misplaced and then finally found.

- 1 The State in the meantime changed applications rules
 - the Town needs a new official Byway Committee
 - Byway Committee need Goals & Action Plan
 - State urges towns to merge with neighboring towns
 - Atkinson to join Hampstead and Chester
 - The Scenic Byway would be called the Old Stage Route Byway
 - Chester and Hampstead told Atkinson to send in application and that they would send theirs along later.
 - Selectman wrote up a new letter of recommendation
- 2 Application to be mailed 11/4/2010

- 1 Ted Stewart wants Committee to apply for Federal Grant to clear poison ivy, fix stonewalls along Byway
- 2 John proposed a walk way
- 3 Byway Committee to send letters to all adjacent homes along the Byway regarding maintenance of Byway

Discussion on the "Tunnel" and that part of Byway is connected to Conservation land and that the Selectmen approved the Official Byway Committee. Hampstead has the "back up" copy of application to use as a guide.

New Budget

Budget Committee wants to make a 5-8% across the board reduction in departmental budgets. Sue presented a schedule to complete the Master Plan as outlined by the RSA and that the Planning Board had a \$9,000 grant for 4 chapter changes during 2009. Discussion on budget and monies needed for the Planning Board.

Bond Releases

Ernest Cherry & Associates has an outstanding bond refund stemming from 12/96 in the amount of \$9,893.88. In 12/03 the Board of Selectmen released the majority and the remaining balance has been on the books.

Mike made a motion to recommend the release of the rest of the bond in the amount of \$9,893.88 (plus interest) to Ernest Cherry & Associates. John seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously in favor to recommend release the rest of the bond.

Anthony DelGrasso for Ridge View Estates has an remaining bond balance of \$4,311.49 plus interest for Indian Ridge and Noyes Lane from 1993. Town has accepted the roads

Mike made a motion to recommend the release the rest of the bond in the amount of \$4,311.49 plus interest to Anthony DelGrasso. John seconded

the motion and the Board voted unanimously in favor to release the rest of the bond.

Eggies

Letter of credit expires on 11/12/2010. Board asked Stantec for a letter. Some trees that were asked to be planted have died (estimate \$250 per tree) \$3,000 is recommended to replace the trees. Board makes the recommendation to hold \$3,000 and to release the surety down to \$3,000

Mike made a motion to release the surety down to the amount of \$3,000. John seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously in favor to release all but \$3,000 of the bond
