## **GENERAL NEWS**

**Holiday Hours:** All Town Offices will be closed Monday, January 17th, in observance of Civil Rights Day.

**Snow Removal Policy:** Now that winter is in full-swing, I want to remind all residents of the Winter Parking Ban and Snow Obstruction ordinances.

- Parking: Per the Snow Removal Policy, the Town has enacted a winter parking ban, which prohibits parking in or on all public ways and town streets between the hours of 12:00 AM and 7:00 AM from November 1 through April 1. Further, it is unlawful at any time of day to park any vehicle on any street during snow removal operations in any way that hinders snow removal. Violators will be fined \$20.00 for each occurrence.
- **Snow Obstruction:** During or after a snow storm, any person who shall put or place snow or ice upon the right of way of any town road... shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$50.00 as provided in RSA 236:20 and the Town Ordinance.

**Christmas Tree Removal:** The Highway Department will be collecting Christmas trees the week of January 3<sup>rd</sup> – January 7<sup>th</sup>. Please put your trees out the same day as your regular trash pickup. Please be aware that your Christmas trees will be picked up separately from your trash and recycling. If you are unable to get your tree out in time, please stop by the Town Hall to pick up a brush and recycling pass to bring your tree to Woodlock Park.

All dogs in the State of NH must be licensed annually by April 30<sup>th</sup> with the town in which the dog resides. Renewals and/or new licenses can be processed on-line at the Town Clerk website or in-person at the Town Clerk's Office. We encourage renewing your currently registered dog anytime after January 1, 2022. All dogs must have a current rabies vaccination in order to newly register or renew.
