



Vital Record Certificate

Birth, Marriage and Death Certificates may be purchased at the Atkinson Town Clerk's Office or by mail for any vital record event that occurred in the State of NH *ONLY*. We do not have access to other state's information. To protect the integrity of vital records and to ensure their proper use, and proper administration of the system of vital statistics, the registrar shall not permit inspection of or disclose information unless he or she is satisfied that the interested party has a direct and tangible interest in such record.

The applicant must be a member of his or her immediate family.

“Immediate Family” means: a person related either by blood or marriage and includes the following: mother, father, son, daughter, brother, sister, husband, wife, grandfather, grandmother, grandson, granddaughter, great-grandchild, step-parents, step-children, aunt, uncles, nephews and nieces (no cousins or in-laws).

A completed application, picture ID and a check addressed to: Town of Atkinson-TC is needed if you apply by mail.

Fees are: \$15.00 for the first certified copy and \$10.00 for each additional certified copy if ordered at the same time.

Disclosure: If we do not find the information you are looking for, we still have to collect the search fee.
